New Student Registration For the 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR Begins Monday, December 1, 2021

****Transitional Kindergarten through 6th Grade****

Enroll now for the 2022 - 2023 school year! Children who turn five between September 2 and February 2, 2022, are eligible for transitional kindergarten (TK), kindergarten children must turn five by September 1, 2022. Early registration for students new to our schools is important for planning, so please help get the word out! We will be sending a brochure home with our primary students. If you know a family to pass this brochure on to it is greatly appreciated.

Interdistrict Transfers

Out of district families must submit an interdistrict transfer form to your district of residence between December 1, 2021 and February 1, 2022. **Renewal forms will be sent home this week**, are available in both school offices, and on our website. You must have the form approved by your district of residence to attend your district of choice. **Remember: This process is required annually for all out of district students, including current students!**
