***Children who <u>turn four</u> by September 1, 2025 are eligible for transitional kindergarten-TK. Children entering Kindergarten must turn five by September 1, 2025. Spread the word!

INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS

Out of district families must submit an interdistrict transfer form to your district of residence between December 1, 2024 and February 1, 2025. Renewal forms have been sent home, and are available in both school offices and on our website. You must have the form approved by your district of residence to attend your district of choice. Remember: This process is required annually for all out of district students, including current students!
