AWAY ALL DAY!

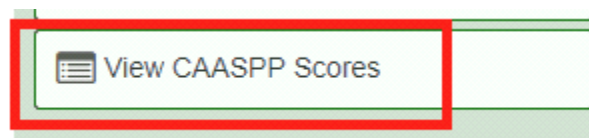
Cell phones, smart watches, and other technological devices need to be silenced or powered off and kept in backpacks all day. All home-school communication needs to be through the office. Thank you.

CUTTEN 4-6TH GRADES: CAASPP RESULTS ARE IN!

1. Navigate to <https://cutten.schoolwise.com/user/login> in a browser on your phone or computer.

2. If you've signed into your account before, it should be the same credentials as last year. Otherwise, select parent sign up, and then select the option that best applies to you. You should receive instructions by e-mail on next steps to create your account.

3. Once you've successfully logged in, at the bottom of the left hand pane, select View CAASPP Scores. This will then present a PDF of the score report to download.

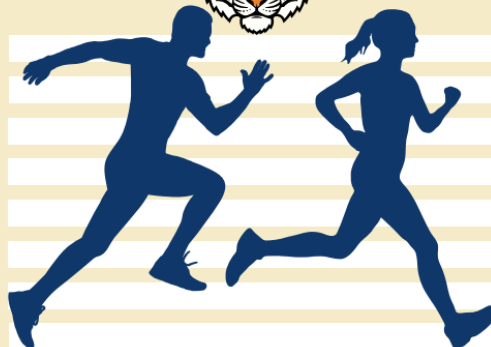
