I want to thank all of our families for adapting to the many challenges related to our school closure. It has been a stressful time for everyone and I want to acknowledge your patience and understanding during this uncertain time. Thanks to the continued collaboration and dedication of our hardworking staff, we continue to provide learning opportunities tailored to our students.

Humboldt County Office of Education and Humboldt County Public Health announced today that the majority of Humboldt County schools are closing campuses and will continue distance learning for the remainder of the school year. Our main priority is the health and safety of our students, families, staff, and community. For this reason, Cutten school campuses will be closed for the remainder of the school year. This does not mean that school is over, but that teachers will continue to deliver education through distance learning.

In light of the extended closure, adjustments have been made to the ways teachers support students. In addition to enrichment activities, teachers will be assigning class work each week. Teachers will work with their aides to support your child(ren)'s learning through online lessons, activities, and resources provided to your child through their Google Classroom accounts. Your child's teacher is also providing opportunities for important social connection between students. They will continue to fine tune their remote lesson planning and help you to problem solve any technology glitches you experience. Teachers are available during their regular work hours Monday through Friday.
