6.1 Cutten Elementary SD Workplace Violence Prevention Plan

The team does not have to take any action, Annette just wants to make the team aware of this plan.

Annette read through the plan thoroughly and was looking for any areas to ensure teacher protection from harm

There is a spreadsheet filled out with all information and monitored by Becky. Darice and Annette enter the data

Every time a CPI hold is done on a student, this information is entered.

Tina said the district encourages all staff to be trained in CPI, Annette wants to become a trainer to make it easier for staff to be trained

CPI is used as a last resort by staff.

6.2 Cutten Learning Continuity Plan

This plan is created in the event that the school would have to shut down for any length of time. This plan would ensure we keep a safe and engaging learning experience.

The reason we need to vote on this plan is because it goes into the Safe Schools Plan which is part of SIPSA

It requires us to have a re-opening plan including four phases of operation, and the effectiveness of the program would have to be monitored.

Instruction needs to be rigorous and inclusive.

Attendance is taken in the schoolwise system.

The number of minutes of instruction required varies by grade level.

Jesse said we would have enough computers to go out to all students in the event of remote learning.

Professional development would be provided to staff

Student support and resources would have to accommodate as much as possible with differentiation for impacted students.

Families would be asked for feedback

Tina brought up the sentences at the top of page 11 referring to teachers teaching students how to go remote in a moment's notice in the first few weeks of the school year. This was discussed as being very difficult for all teachers to do, and close to impossible for students in TK-second grade. Annette added in parentheses something to the effect of "as appropriate for the grade level"

Carissa thought it might be helpful for teachers to show families some of the sites used and then these could be accessed on the website.
