6.0 DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS

6.1 Review Student Wellness policies: AG 5030/ BP5030

Comments/Notes on Wellness Report and Wellness in general:

- Student learning about health/nutritional wellness woven into teaching curriculum.
- As of last 2 years, Ridgewood has warmer to keep hot lunches hot.
- Ridgewood, mostly limited outdoor options for lunch: Majority served outside. If inclement weather, Rainbow Room and classrooms are the options.
- Because we serve K-6, no meal size differential can be offered between 6th and TK, for example. A problem of waste?
- Cutten has a better way to manage unused food. Ridgewood does not have a full kitchen.
- Composting, though labor intensive, is a possible solution (see notes below on beautification).
- New building to break ground by Aug 30: Front Office; Classroom; modify kitchen.

Morgan moved to accept Wellness Report: Chara 2nd. Passed unanimously.

6.2 Beautification Event debrief- April 17th, 2025

- Handful in the garden from the beginning. Painting of stars, led by Coach Bon appreciated. Sparsely attended, but got a good start in the garden.
- Perhaps **not** do beatification event next year, different approach to upkeep.
- Annette: For next year: weave it into curriculum. Each class has a week to be responsible for beautification. (Has been done previously.)
- Morgan: Garden Club could be connected to that initiative.
- Morgan has ideas for projects.
- Currently: Thursday Garden Club: Kids come after school Thursdays with parent/guardian. ASP also has participated. Perhaps enlist more adult supervision from ASP for greater productivity on projects. Suggested to make Thursday the ASP "movie day" to facilitate that. "Papa Toms" has participated. Morgan will create a group text of attendees, with consent. She may engage Sue from Green Lots for counsel.

- Question about the greenhouse key: Morgan can leave key with ASP if office closed by her departure.
- Morgan: Can we have lockbox with key or padlock with passcode for those who
 may want to come and water? For now, Morgan will have key for summer.
- Funding?: PTA? Grants? Budget? Apparently, there are grants "out there" for school gardens... How do we find?
- Annette and Morgan to meet separately to plan further garden care and consider resources.
- If we had an active garden club, "Moving Bodies, Growing Vegetables" could be part of wellness curriculum/health learning.
- Sean: Ace does donations. As do Pierson and Schmidbauer.
- Present and future wish list: COMPOST BINS:

IN GARDEN: Worm bin. Tumblers that lock. If we wanted to start composting, some infrastructure is already in place. Needs commitment from humans: It is a big commitment including labor and someone who knows how to compost. Would need a project head. Education of kids and oversight, etc.

6.3 End of Term/ Thank Yous Site Council Membership

- Melissa, Teacher, has completed term. Melissa's replacement would be only Ridgewood Teacher. (Annette to confirm that's OK, given Annette also represents Ridgewood.)
- Shandi, Tina, Chara will be teachers at Cutten for 2025-26.
 All in 1st year of 1st term.
- Carissa, Parent: 1st term, 2nd year, willing to run again
- Morgan, Parent: 1st year, 1st term
- Teresa, Parent: 1st term, 1st year
- Sean, Parent: 3rd term, 1st year (TBC)
- Nancy: 2nd term, 2nd year. Question: Can substitute (who is also parent) serve as parent rep on Site Council?

6.4 Cell Phone Policy

- 1st Sentence after Section 1: Should this be a bullet? If sentence, include "shall be used"? Or if a bullet/title, include the word "usage".
- Define school hours:
 - What about policy for bus travel (not during school hours proper but in "school" care). However, on the bus, it cannot fall to the driver to enforce it. Consequence would only come from significant infraction.

- Progressive consequences outlined in policy deemed appropriate and strongly affirmed.
